The present continuous is made from the **present tense of the verb** be and the **-**ing form of a verb:

Affirmative Forms


l am	visit ing different places.
You are	visiti ng different places.
He is	visiti ng different places.
She is	visiti ng different places.
lt is	visiti ng different places.
We are	visiti ng different places.
They are	visiti ng different places.

Negative Forms

l am not	visiting different places.
You are not	visiting different places.
He is not	visiting different places.
She is not	visiting different places.
It is not	visiting different places.
We are not	visiting different places.
They are not	visit ing different places.

Interrogative Forms

Am I	visiting different places?
Are you	visiting different places?
Is he	visiting different places?
Is she	visiting different places?
Is it	visiting different places?
Are we	visiting different places?
Are they	visiting different places?
