

# Present Continuous Tense



Lo ocupamos para hablar de actividades que están ocurriendo en el momento en el que estamos hablando.

The present continuous is made from the **present tense of the verb *be*** and the ***-ing form*** of a verb:

## Affirmative Forms

I <b>am</b>	visiting different places.
You <b>are</b>	visiting different places.
He <b>is</b>	visiting different places.
She <b>is</b>	visiting different places.
It <b>is</b>	visiting different places.
We <b>are</b>	visiting different places.
They <b>are</b>	visiting different places.

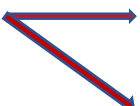
## Negative Forms

I <b>am not</b>	visiting different places.
You <b>are not</b>	visiting different places.
He <b>is not</b>	visiting different places.
She <b>is not</b>	visiting different places.
It <b>is not</b>	visiting different places.
We <b>are not</b>	visiting different places.
They <b>are not</b>	visiting different places.

## Interrogative Forms

<b>Am I</b>	visiting different places?
<b>Are you</b>	visiting different places?
<b>Is he</b>	visiting different places?
<b>Is she</b>	visiting different places?
<b>Is it</b>	visiting different places?
<b>Are we</b>	visiting different places?
<b>Are they</b>	visiting different places?

## Wh Questions



**What?** (¿Qué?), **How?** (¿Cómo?), **Why?** (¿Por qué?), **Where?** (¿Dónde?),

**How many?** (¿Cuántos?), **When** (¿Cuándo?).

**What are you doing?**, **How is she doing** her homework?, **Why is he doing** this?,

**Where are you eating?** **How many** restaurants **are you visiting** today?, etc.
